Symbiotic Relationships

Symbiosis: A close relationship between 2 species that benefits at least 1 species.

Mutualism: Both species benefit (+,+)

<u>Commensalism</u>: One species benefits and the other is neither helped nor harmed. (+, 0)

Parasitism: One species benefits while the other is harmed (+, -) ex: tick and dog

Parasite: the organism that benefits.

<u>Host</u>: the organism the parasite lives in or on.
